## HIGHLIGHTS

### ITALIAN EUSALP KICK OFF MEETING

The Italian event launching the Macro-regional Alpine Strategy (EUSALP) was held in Milan, at the headquarters of the Lombardy Region, on 26th February. During the kick off meeting of Action Groups 1, 2 and 3, jointly operating as part of Axis 1 of the Strategy, regarding "economic growth and innovation," Anna Giorgi, Group 1 leader, announced the development of virtual collaborative tables and environments to facilitate gathering information, continuous and clear monitoring of processes and continuous networking between those involved in various countries and regions.

She also confirmed that young people will be actively involved in spreading the Strategy actions effectively. In addition, Universities in the Alpine Region will play a leading role within EUSALP in order to provide high level and up-to-date training, an indispensable tool for preparing tomorrow's citizens and ensuring their well-being in the macro-regional area, both in the plains and in the mountains.

### EVENT DEDICATED TO YOUNG MOUNTAIN ENTREPRENEURS

An afternoon event dedicated to young mountain entrepreneurs was held on Tuesday, 23rd February at the Mountain University Campus in Edolo.

ReStartAlp, the new initiative promoted by [Garrone Foundation](#), [Fondazione Cariplo](#) and [UNIMONT](#) was presented: a free campus for 15 young aspiring alpine entrepreneurs, which in addition to high quality training, includes prizes worth a total of € 60,000 in favour of the best start-ups.

Giovanni Fava, Councillor for Agriculture of the Lombardy Regional Government, and successful young entrepreneurs focused on the agriculture, food and forestry sector as regards opportunities arising as part of the new Rural Development Programme 2014-2020.

The meeting saw the participation of more than XX people including university and high school students, entrepreneurs and citizens from throughout the Lombardy region.

### "NERO SPINOSO" CORN

The process to register the "nero spinoso" corn of Vallecamonica in the conservation varieties section of the Italian National Register of Agricultural and Horticultural Species has ended successfully. The application was submitted by the Centre of Applied Studies for the Sustainable Management and Protection of Mountain Areas (Ge.S.Di.Mont.) in collaboration with the Municipalities of Piancogno and Esine in March 2015. In January 2016 the [Ministerial Decree dated 12/14/2015](#) "Registration of a conservation variety of corn in the national

protection. The caryopses, as well as being brown/black in colour with a clear spike, contain a large amount of phlobaphenes, molecules that possess antioxidant properties capable of preventing chronic diseases. The registration of this ancient variety, traditionally grown in the Middle Valle Camonica (BS), therefore represents an important attainment safeguarding Italian agro-biodiversity and enriching the agro-food heritage of the Valle Camonica.

## ADVANCED COURSE IN ROCK ART

The course in "Recording Art Rock. New methods for the documentation and management of alpine and valley heritage" is organized by UNIMONT in collaboration with the [Valcamonica Centre for Prehistoric Studies](#) in order to train new experts and transform historical and cultural heritage into opportunities for the sustainable development and economic growth of such areas. The course aims to provide participants with a wide view both geographically and chronologically, and to bring together complementary disciplines, so as to provide practical skills to future specialists in rock art.

The lessons will include both theoretical and practical sessions on mapping using GPS and total station as well as the creation and management of databases. There will also be lectures on geoarchaeology and archaeobotany as well as the conservation and restoration of archaeological heritage.

The course offers the possibility of learning and gaining practical experience to European students and graduates, offering lectures and contributions from professors and other experts working in Italy, Spain, Portugal, Scandinavia and England. The course also provides access to

## TRAINING and JOB OFFERS

### INTERNSHIP PLANT BIOLOGY

UNIMONT students who have passed the exam in Plant Biology and Plant Ecology can apply for the internship: "Distribution of *Linaria tonzigii* in upper Val Brembana (Monte Cavallo, Orobic Bergamo)".

*Linaria tonzigii* is a rare and steno-endemic plant of the Bergamo Prealps inserted in the IUCN red list of threatened species and Annex II of the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC). Currently *Linaria tonzigii* populations are only partially in protected areas; it is therefore necessary to identify examples of this species and activate appropriate conservation procedures.

picture of the presence of this species in the area and to evaluate possible conservation strategies.

Field work will be conducted mainly during summer 2016. The data collected will be analysed using GIS software at the Ge.S.Di.Mont centre in Edolo.

#### PASTURS PROJECT

Two very important species that spark both enthusiasm and controversy are returning to the Orobie mountains: the bear and the wolf. The conflict between large carnivores and livestock activities is one of the main reasons for the persecution carried out by man against these predators. The risk of potential damage can be reduced through the adoption of preventive measures. The Pasturs project has been set up to train young people as regards these preventive measures.

Volunteers, after following a short free training course, spend a period in alpine pastures (min 1 week – period: June to September) in the province of Bergamo, with flocks of sheep and/or goats, assisting the shepherd in his daily work.

For adults who love the outdoor life taking part in this project can be a memorable experience, helping shepherds, contributing to the protection of bears and wolves, and supporting traditional farming.

Students are offered internships and the recognition of credits compatibly with the University attended.

#### YOUNG ACADEMICS AWARD

The competition "Young Academics Award 2016: Green economy in the Alps" is aimed at young graduates interested in mountain issues.

The initiative, sponsored by the German Presidency of the [Alpine Convention](#), the [Permanent Secretariat of the Alpine Convention](#) and the Infopoint of the Alpine Convention [Foundation Grand Paradis](#), [Domodossola](#) and [Morbegno](#), will reward the best master's degree theses, written in 2014, 2015 and 2016, on the theme of the green economy in the Alps and in particular on the following related topics:

- energy efficiency and an economy with low CO2 emissions (including initiatives in specific alpine sectors such as mountain agriculture, tourism, management of water and energy resources, transport);
- an economy that uses resources efficiently (including waste management);
- ecosystem services and an economy based on natural capital;
- an economy that promotes quality of life and well-being.

There are three major awards (1000, 750 and 500 euro) as well as three additional "Infopoint Awards" for theses dealing with topics relating to Infopoint issues and sectors.

### CIASPOLANDO 2016

On 13th February, a group of students from the Mountain University took part in "Ciaspolando 2016", a snowshoe event organized by Decathlon Castione Andevenno at Alpe di Teglio (SO). During the day there were various activities related to the environment, to winter sports and to the typical food of the Valtellina. In particular UNIMONT students provided participants with scientific and technical information regarding various environmental aspects of mountains in winter (climate change, retreat of glaciers, environmental impact of heating homes, fauna and flora adaptation to winter weather, agricultural activities in mountain areas). Appropriately themed posters created by the students as a result of a research project conducted in collaboration with Unimont lecturers provided additional information.
