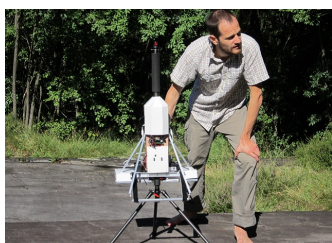

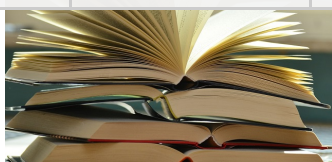

SECOND CARAVAN OF THE ALPS' SUMMIT

On Saturday 2nd July, 2016, at the Cultural Center Lou Pourtounore of Ostana (Cuneo), from 9:00 to 18:00 will be held the Second Caravan of the Alps' Summit, dealing with the theme of: "The mountain resettlement between administrative rules and land management". The initiative, promoted by [Legambiente](#) and the [municipality of Ostana](#), sponsored by the [Regional Council of Piedmont](#), will see the participation of various institutions engaged in the promotion and development of the mountain areas. The Mountain University, represented by Anna Giorgi and Emanuela Zilio, will be present confirming that Unimont collaborates in all the alpine areas where mountains are resources and not a disadvantage.

PRE-ENROLMENT FOR THE DEGREE COURSE IN CONSERVATION AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF MOUNTAIN AREAS

The degree courses of the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences have all been with closed-number access since the academic year 2014-15. This is the case also for the Course in Conservation and Sustainable Development of Mountain Areas which takes place in Edolo. Students therefore have to register for an entry test and pass the selection procedure (admission depends on a candidate's position in the ranking of test results). The test is the same for all the degree programmes and takes place at the same time.

Pre-enrolment opens on 15th July and ends on 26th August 2016 and the entry test will be held in Milan on 5th September, 2016 at 9.00 am.

75 places are available for the course in Edolo.

ALVINA PROJECT STARTS: WALK THROUGH THE ALPS IN 2 STAGES WITH EDOLO AT THE CENTRE

Walk through the Alps in 2 stages: from Trieste to Edolo and then from Ventimiglia to Edolo, with the Mountain University at the centre. This is the dream, now becoming reality, of Prof. [Marcello Duranti](#) of the University of Milan. Alvina is an acronym for "Alpine Virtual Nation", to evoke the idea of a single united Alpine Region. But how can this idea be represented in practical terms? Prof Duranti has chosen an itinerary which covers the whole of the Italian alps, with Edolo (BS), with its Mountain University – a University of Milan campus – the objective for both journeys, demonstrating how culture and science can help to enhance this unique territory. A symbolic embrace that includes many of the 48 Alpine areas in seven European countries, in order to gain experience and (re) discover all types of "diversity": first of all, bio-diversity, but also topo diversity and ethno-diversity as well as climate diversity.

Marcello Duranti left from Opicina, Trieste, on 11th June, and you can follow him on his

ANNA GIORGI SPEAKER FOR WIRE 2016

The [Vanguard Initiative](#) – new growth through smart specialization – organized a conference as part of the Week of Innovative Regions of Europe ([WIRE 2016](#)) in Eindhoven on 9th June.

The conference, on the theme of "Cross-Regional Partnerships for new industrial value chains: lessons from past experiences and future needs", centred on experiences of cross-regional collaboration for industrial processing, identifying bottlenecks and emerging needs, and opened the way towards future political developments. The session brought together high-level speakers, including Anna Giorgi, lecturer at the Mountain University and leader of the Eusalp Action group on research and innovation.

COURSE ABOUT MOUNTAIN LEGISLATION

The Mountain University, thanks to the Framework Convention stipulated between the Department of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences – Production, Landscape, Agroenergy ([DISAA](#)) and the Centre of Applied Studies for the Sustainable Management and Protection of Mountain Areas (GESDIMONT), will work with the Fondazione Montagne Italia ([FMI](#)) to perform educational activities and research.

Fondazione Montagne Italia was established in August 2014, on the initiative of [UNCEM](#) and [FEDERBIM](#), in order to effectively support mountain municipalities, unions of mountain municipalities and BIM Consortia, combining heritage, resources, skills and regional networks and promoting the development of mountain regions.

The first step in this partnership will be the joint organization of a training course dedicated to mountain legislation entitled: "The development of mountain areas: strategies, tools and governance".

The course, open to high school and university graduates, is aimed in particular at staff of Public Administrations in mountain areas (park authorities, regions and provinces, including those which are autonomous, mountain unions, etc.), as well as at the staff of international organizations and local administrators, but is also open to all those who have dealings with Public Administrations (technicians, public companies, private companies and consultants). The course, lasting 37 hours, will be taught entirely via the virtual classroom, and will start in September 2016.

TRAINING and JOB OFFERS

INTERNSHIP ON PASTURE ASSESSMENT

An internship is available to be carried out in the municipalities of Parre, Gorno, Oneta, Ponte Nossia and Premolo (BG) for the environmental, livestock and sustainability assessment of the alpine pastures present in these areas. The objective is to draw up a project to develop the area which takes account of livestock and agronomic (herbaceous and woody) production potential as well as any tourist and economic aspects of future sustainable development. Students will have to carry out surveys on the current conditions of pasture and forest areas (and must have followed the course of Agronomy and also have some ability to recognize flora species) and will develop potential strategies for improvement. Information we will also be gathered on livestock management (use of pastures, milk production and cheese, nutritional and zootechnical assessment). Each student may work on one or more of the issues to be studied, taking into consideration existing data as well as performing field work.

The Mountain University streamed the conference “START CUP LOMBARDIA 2016: PRESENTATION AND TESTIMONIALS”, which took place on 8th June at 4.30 p.m. at Milan University.

Start Cup Lombardia, now in its 14th edition, is a competition that aims to identify and reward the best business ideas arising in university which are highly innovative in the sectors of Information Technology & Services; Life Science & Agrofood; Clean & Industrial Technologies. INAUGURATION RESTARTALP CAMPUS

The opening event of the ReStartAlp campus, the first incubator for the development of business ideas and start-ups engaged in typical supply chains in Alpine areas was held on 20th June in Premia, Verbano Cusio Ossola,

FIELD TRIP TO VAL FONTANA (CHIURO – SONDRIO)

On Tuesday 14th and Wednesday 15th June students of the second and third year of the degree course in "Conservation and Sustainable Development of Mountain Areas" went on a field trip to Val Fontana (Chiuro, SO) accompanied by Prof. Silvana Mattiello, Prof. Giorgio Scari and Dr. Luca Giupponi.

The trip, which took place at the end of the course in "Wildlife Heritage Management", held by Prof. Mattiello, allowed students to observe various alpine ungulates (deer, roe deer and chamois) in their natural environment. This allowed students to test and expand the knowledge learned during theory lessons. The trip ended with a visit to the Wildlife Rescue Centre in Chiuro where there were several injured wild animals undergoing rehabilitation.

FIELD TRIP TO ALPE CULINO (VAL GEROLA – SONDRIO)

On Tuesday, 14th June students of the first year of the degree course in "Conservation and Sustainable Development of Mountain Areas" went on a field trip to Val Gerola (Alpe Culino, Rasura SO), accompanied by Dr. Luca Giupponi and Giordano Giumelli (ERSAF Morbegno). During the trip students were able to concretely appreciate the complexity of Alpine agro-ecosystems, paying particular attention to botanical-forestry and agro-pastoral aspects of

important work carried out to support those who live and work in the mountains, and for the conservation of nature and the mountain territory.
