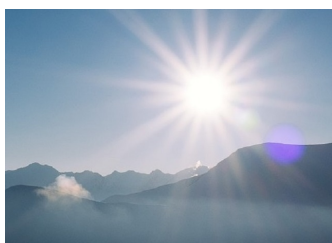

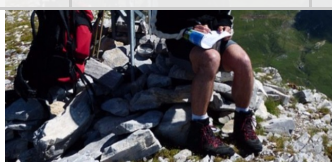

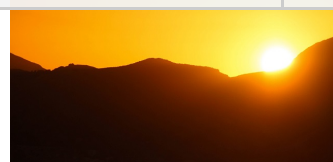

## NEWS HIGHLIGHTS

### ENROLLMENT OPEN FOR ADVANCED COURSE IN ROCK ART

You have time only till the 30th June to enroll to the course in "Recording Art Rock. New methods for the documentation and management of alpine and valley heritage".

The course has been organized by UNIMONT in collaboration with the [Valcamonica Centre for Prehistoric Studies](#) in order to train new experts and transform historical and cultural heritage into opportunities for the sustainable development and economic growth of such areas. The course aims to provide participants with a wide view both geographically and chronologically, and to bring together complementary disciplines.

The advanced course offers the possibility of learning and gaining practical experience to European students and graduates, offering lectures and contributions from professors and other experts working in Italy, Spain, Portugal, Scandinavia and England. The course also provides access to the Centre's network of experts at universities and research institutes across Europe. The course, which is intensive, will take place from 22nd August to 3rd September 2016 with an introductory lesson online on 29th July.

### CONFERENCE "WHICH DIRECTION FOR MOUNTAIN AREAS?"

The day dedicated to reflecting on the future of mountain areas was a great success. The conference "Which direction for mountain areas?", which was held on 27th May at the Mountain University and was organized in memory of Prof. Luigi Zanzi, dealt with issues of the Alpine Macro-region and the Alps from a socio-economic and cultural viewpoint. Speakers included important business, scientific and institutional representatives, who provided the numerous participants with a thorough analysis of the problems faced by mountain regions, but also of new opportunities for sustainable development.

### ALPINE MACROREGIONAL STRATEGY

The alpine macro-regional strategy is quickly making progress in the field of innovation and research. The Lombardy Region, which coordinates the seven Italian regions participating in Eusalp, organized the workshop "Industrial Modernisation: the Alpine Macroregion as a driver for the European industry of tomorrow", held in Brussels on 11th May.

During the meeting, which was also attended by the Vice President of the Lombardy Region Fabrizio Sala, the President of Confindustria Lombardia Alberto Ribolla, and the deputy permanent representative for the EU, Giovanni Puglisi, Anna Giorgi, lecturer at the Mountain University and leader of the Eusalp action group dealing with research and innovation, informed the audience about Eusalp's recent developments and announced that later this year the first concrete tools will be activated to start joint work, such as a georeferenced map of the clusters

### UNIMONT IN THE MOUNTAIN RESEARCH INITIATIVE NETWORK

The Mountain Research Initiative (MRI) – a very important non-profit research coordination office funded by the Swiss National Science Foundation and hosted by the University of Bern – has asked the Mountain University to collaborate by periodically publishing posts on the MRI blog, in order to disseminate information about the unique experience of the Edolo campus throughout the network. ## UPCOMING EVENTS

### COURSE ABOUT MOUNTAIN LEGISLATION

The Mountain University, thanks to the Framework Convention stipulated between the Department of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences – Production, Landscape, Agroenergy (DISAA) and the Centre of Applied Studies for the Sustainable Management and Protection of Mountain Areas (GESDIMONT), will work with the [Fondazione Montagne Italia](#) (FMI) to perform educational activities and research.

Fondazione Montagne Italia was established in August 2014, on the initiative of [UNCERM](#) and [FEDERBIM](#), in order to effectively support mountain municipalities, unions of mountain municipalities and BIM Consortia, combining heritage, resources, skills and regional networks and promoting the development of mountain regions

The first step in this partnership will be the joint organization of a training course dedicated to mountain legislation entitled: "The development of mountain areas: strategies, tools and governance".

The course, open to high school and university graduates, is aimed in particular at staff of Public Administrations in mountain areas (park authorities, regions and provinces, including those which are autonomous, mountain unions, etc.), as well as at the staff of international organizations and local administrators, but is also open to all those who have dealings with Public Administrations (technicians, public companies, private companies and consultants). The course, lasting 34 hours, will be taught entirely via the virtual classroom, and will start in September 2016.

### ANNA GIORGI SPEAKER AT WIRE 2016

The [Vanguard Initiative](#) – new growth through smart specialisation is hosting a session at the [WIRE 2016](#) Conference (Eindhoven, 9 June 2016).

Under the topic "Cross-regional collaboration for new industrial value chains : lessons from experience and needs for the future", the session will aim at sharing various experiences in cross-regional collaboration for industrial transformation, identifying bottlenecks and emerging needs, and paving the way towards future policy developments.

The session will gather high level speakers, including Anna Giorgi, professor at the Mountain University, who will exchange views in a lively discussion.

### INTERNSHIP ON PASTURE ASSESSMENT

An internship is available to be carried out in the municipalities of Parre, Gorno, Oneta, Ponte Nossa and Premolo (BG) for the environmental, livestock and sustainability assessment of the alpine pastures present in these areas. The objective is to draw up a project to develop the area which takes account of livestock and agronomic (herbaceous and woody) production potential as well as any tourist and economic aspects of future sustainable development. Students will have to carry out surveys on the current conditions of pasture and forest areas (and must have followed the course of Agronomy and also have some ability to recognize flora species) and will develop potential strategies for improvement. Information we will also be gathered on livestock management (use of pastures, milk production and cheese, nutritional and zootechnical assessment). Each student may work on one or more of the issues to be studied, taking into consideration existing data as well as performing field work.

#### CONFERENCE ON NON-PRODUCTIVE ECOSYSTEM SERVICES

The conference "Non-productive ecosystem services of alpine forests", held by Dott.ssa Roberta Berretti and Dott. Giorgio Vacchiano, University of Turin, took place on Tuesday, 24th May at the Mountain University. The speakers described three of the most important "non-productive" ecosystem services performed by alpine forests: direct protection from slope processes and their quantification by the "evaluation of the protective role of the plant population"; biodiversity and management aimed at ensuring this.

The conference "Old-growth forests in Italy and Lombardy: definition, structural characteristics, importance and role in sustainable forest management" took place on Tuesday, 17th May.

The situation of these forests in Italy and in Lombardy and their role in the sustainable management of natural resources was presented and discussed with examples and references to recent research conducted by DISAFA on behalf of ERSAF by Prof. Renzo Motta of the Department of Agriculture, Forest and Food Sciences (DISAFA) of the University of Turin.

#### CONFERENCE ON TREE AND SLOPE STABILITY

The conference regarding the "Stability of trees and slopes in mountain areas: case studies in the Alps and the Apennines" was held on Thursday, 12th May.

Prof. Donato Chiatante recounted the experience of the laboratory of Environmental and Applied Botany, University of Insubria, which studies modifications in the root architecture of trees in response to slope angle. The results of these studies can help to guide forest management and restoration strategies in order to combat natural disasters.
