PRE-ENROLMENT FOR THE DEGREE COURSE IN CONSERVATION AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF MOUNTAIN AREAS

The degree courses of the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences have all been with **closed-number access** since the academic year 2014-15. This is also the case for the Course in **Conservation and Sustainable Development of Mountain Areas** which takes place in Edolo. Students therefore have to register for an entry test and pass the selection procedure (admission depends on a candidate's position in the ranking of test results). The test is the same for all the degree programmes and takes place at the same time.

The deadline for pre-enrolment is on 26th August, 2016 at 12 noon and the entry test will be held in Milan on 5th September, 2016 at 9.00 am.

75 places are available for the course in Edolo.

2nd July, 2016 - THE MOUNTAIN UNIVERSITY AT THE SECOND SUMMIT OF THE ALPINE CARAVAN IN OSTANA

The **Second Summit of the Caravan of the Alps organized by Legambiente**, dealing with: **"Resettlement of mountain areas: administrative reorganization and territorial management"** was held on Saturday, **2nd July, 2016**, at the Centro Polifunzionale e Culturale Lou Pourtounore in Ostana (Cuneo), from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. The event, promoted by Legambiente and by the municipality of Ostana and sponsored by the Regional Council of Piedmont involved many institutions working for the promotion and development of mountain areas.

Representatives of Uncem, Legambiente, Cipra Italia, the Maritime Alps Park and the Monviso Park were joined by the Mountain University, represented by **Anna Giorgi and Emanuela Zilio**, confirming that Unimont collaborates and is present in all alpine areas where mountains are seen as a resource and not as a disadvantage. During the afternoon, regional and municipal councilors spoke about best practices in mountainous areas, such as Ostana, which have been able to reverse the depopulation trend by giving new life and a new future for upland areas based on local traditions. The event also provided the opportunity to exchange seeds and small plants of local vegetable varieties.

18th JULY, 2016: PRESENTATION OF THE 2nd MOUNTAIN REPORT ITALY 2016 ROME - THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES

The presentation of the **2nd report on the Mountains of Italy 2016** was held on Monday 18th July in the Group Room of the **Chamber of Deputies** - Palazzo dei Gruppi - Via Uffici del Vicario 21, Rome. The speakers were: Hon. Enrico Borghi (President of the Parliamentary Intergroup for the development of Mountain Areas); Giampiero Lupatelli (Fondazione Montagne Italia); Luca Lo Bianco (Scientific Director Fondazione Montagne Italia); Fabio Piacenti (Fondazione Montagne Italia).

The President of the Cariplo Foundation Giuseppe Guzzetti, the President of the Garrone Foundation Alessandro Garrone, the Undersecretary for Regional Affairs and Autonomy Gianclaudio Bressa, Prof. Fabrizio Barca, the President of the Parliamentary Environment Committee Hon. Ermete Realacci, the Deputy Minister of Agricultural Policies Andrea Olivero, Labour Undersecretary Hon. Luigi Bobba, the Council of Ministers Presidency Undersecretary Hon. Claudio De Vincenti, the Undersecretary for Economic Development Hon. Antonello Giacomelli, Dr. Massimo Bruno (Enel) and the Director of Confcooperative Dr. Giovanni Teneggi were invited to the debate.

Findings will be entrusted to the Minister for Regional Affairs and Autonomy Enrico Costa.

28th JULY 2016: 1st STAGE OF ALVINA PROJECT COMPLETED: WALK THROUGH THE ALPS IN 2 STAGES WITH EDOLO AT THE CENTRE

Walk through the Alps in 2 stages: from Trieste to Edolo and then from Ventimiglia to Edolo, with the Mountain University at the centre. This is the dream, now a reality, of **Prof. Marcello Duranti of the University of Milan**. Alvina is an acronym for "**Alpine Virtual Nation**", to evoke the idea of a single united Alpine Region. But how can this idea be represented in practical terms? Prof. Duranti has chosen an itinerary which covers the whole of the Italian alps, with Edolo (BS), with its Mountain University - a University of Milan campus - the objective for both journeys, demonstrating how culture and science can help to enhance this unique territory. A symbolic embrace that includes many of the **48 Alpine areas in seven European countries**, in order to gain experience and (re) discover all types of "diversity": first of all, bio-diversity, but also topo diversity and ethno-diversity as well as climate diversity.

Marcello Duranti left from Opicina, Trieste, on 11th June, and arrived in Edolo on 28th July.

(T)TITUDINI D’INNOVAZIONE” FOR EXILLESFEST2016 – TURIN AND THE ALPS

On Saturday 6th August 2016 **Anna Giorgi (Mountain University), together with** Luca Mercalli (Nimbus); Marco Bussone (UNCEN Piedmont); Beppe Dematteis (Dislivelli), will take part in this meeting, with an introduction by Antonio De Rossi (Polytechnic University of Turin), focusing on how the mountains have always been a space for experimentation and innovation. While this aspect of the territory has not always been fully appreciated, it is in the Alps that European science has made essential discoveries for the modern world; it is in the Alpine region that fundamental technological innovations for cities and plains have been experimented. Today the mountains are seen primarily as a place for conservation: of nature, of history, of cultures. **But can the Alps once again act as a space for innovation and development?**

The alpine farmsteads are part of the heritage that ERSAF manages, on behalf of the Lombardy Region, in 20 regional forests. Of varying size and characteristics, they are granted to farms by tender, mainly for several years at a time. These concessions periodically expire and may be renewed or put out to tender as is in this case.

ERSAF recently changed the rules regarding the concession procedure to provide more incentives for **young farmers, and generally for local family-run farms** which can make a significant impact on the **conservation of biodiversity and landscape** and help maintain mountain areas.

COURSE ABOUT MOUNTAIN LEGISLATION

The Mountain University, thanks to the Framework Convention stipulated between the Department of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences - Production, Landscape, Agroenergy (DISAA) and the Centre of Applied Studies for the Sustainable Management and Protection of Mountain Areas (GESDIMONT), will work with the Fondazione Montagne Italia (FMI) to perform educational activities and research. Fondazione Montagne Italia was established in August 2014, on the initiative of UNCEM and FEDERBIM, in order to effectively support mountain municipalities, unions of mountain municipalities and BIM Consortia, combining heritage, resources, skills and regional networks and promoting the development of mountain regions.

The first step in this partnership will be the joint organization of a training course dedicated to mountain legislation entitled: "The development of mountain areas: strategies, tools and governance".

The course, open to high school and university graduates, is aimed in particular at staff of Public Administrations in mountain areas (park authorities, regions and provinces, including those which are autonomous, mountain unions, etc.), as well as at the staff of international organizations and local administrators, but is also open to all those deal with Public Administrations (technicians, public companies, private companies and consultants).

The course, lasting 37 hours, will be taught entirely via the virtual classroom, and will start in October 2016.

INTERNSHIP ON PASTURE ASSESSMENT

An internship is available to be carried out in the municipalities of Parre, Gorno, Oneta, Ponte Nossa and Premolo (BG) for the environmental, livestock and sustainability assessment of the alpine pastures present in these areas. The objective is to draw up a project to develop the area which takes account of livestock and agronomic (herbaceous and woody) production potential as well as any tourist and economic aspects of future sustainable development. Students will have to carry out surveys on the current conditions of pasture and forest areas (and must have followed the course of Agronomy and also have some ability to recognize flora species) and will develop potential strategies for improvement. Information we will also be gathered on livestock management (use of pastures, milk production and cheese, nutritional and zootechnical assessment). Each student may work on one or more of the issues to be studied, taking into consideration existing data as well as performing field work.


