LOMBARDY REGION PUBLISHES FINAL DISSERTATION BY MOUNTAIN UNIVERSITY STUDENT

The *Lombardy Region General Management of Green Areas and Landscape* has issued a statement regarding the publication of the **"Forests Report"** and of the thesis **"Overview of forestry enterprises in the Lombardy Region"** written by a student of the Conservation and Sustainable Development of Mountain areas undergraduate course based at the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Science in Edolo (BS).

The dissertation by **Attilio Melesi**, entitled "Overview of forestry enterprises in the Lombardy Region" and discussed in July 2012, provides a thorough investigation of 197 forestry enterprises listed in the Lombardy register, focusing on personnel, equipment and personal protective equipment, as well as the activities carried out. Data refer to **2008-2010**.

The results of the research were also presented on December 12, 2012 at **Palazzo Pirelli** during the presentation of the "Lombardy Forests Report."

The research was carried out as part of an internship at the Regional Agency for Services to Agriculture and Forestry (ERSAF) and is a good example of how the final papers of students attending the Conservation and Sustainable Development of Mountain areas undergraduate course can be useful for local administrations.

2013 ADVANCED COURSES AT THE MOUNTAIN UNIVERSITY IN EDOLO
