The Ge.S.Di.Mont. Research Center of UNIMONT, as a member representing the University of Milan, participated in the 2020 General Assembly of Euromontana (European multisectoral association for cooperation and development of mountain territories), which met to renew its Board for the next four years and to discuss its next priorities for the sustainable development of mountain areas. On that occasion, Anna Giorgi was elected as member of the Board for Italy. Participation in the Euromontana Board will allow UNIMONT to strengthen collaboration and **dialogue in a European context** and promote new international strategic initiatives for the development and promotion of Italian and European mountain territories.

The [Ge.S.Di.Mont. Research Centre of UNIMONT - Centre of Excellence of the University of Milan](#), which has supported the Lombardy Region in the leadership of Action Group 1 since the beginning of the EUSALP strategy, participated in the event "Eusalp and stakeholders: Innovative solutions for the new EU programming period" organized by Lombardy Region and held on 11th November, with the aim of presenting the potential of digital tools to promote collaboration in the Alpine Region. As evidence of the fact that technology and partnership are successful ingredients for innovation, two results achieved by the [Italian Presidency of EUSALP](#) were presented: the agreement between the Italian municipalities within the European Strategy for the Alpine Region and the Manifesto of young entrepreneurs of EUSALP. INVESTIGATION ON THE RISKS, BENEFITS AND MANAGEMENT OF NON-NATIVE TREE SPECIES (IT)

The survey, conducted by the partner institutions of the [ALPTREES](#) project in Austria, Germany, Italy, France and Slovenia and approved by the "Institution" Ethics Council, aims to collect knowledge, observations and suggestions on the management of non-native tree species which have long been

part of the Alpine Region. The data collected through the questionnaire will be analyzed for scientific purposes only by the research team of the [Federal Research and Training Center for Forests, Natural Hazards and Landscape, BFW, Austria](#) and the results will be presented through informative reports, techniques, scientific journals and conferences. NATIONAL CALL FOR SELECTION OF PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ASSOCIATIONS OR CONSORCIA FOR MANAGING SILVO-PASTORAL AREAS (IT)

The Ministry of Agricultural, Food and Forestry Policies" has issued a call for project proposals for the establishment of associations or consortia for the management of silvo-pastoral areas" (DMN 13329 dated 22/04/2020), part of the Development and Cohesion Fund 2014-2020 - Agriculture Operational Plan - Subplan 3. Subplan 3 has the objective of stimulating the **creation of new forms of association or consortia** for the management of silvo-pastoral areas, so as to **counteract the fragmentation of properties** in mountain areas and to **improve the active management** of the territory, while at the same time **enhancing local production, environmental and social vocations** and supporting the development of **business networks**.

The Call is aimed at the **whole of Italy** and provides for funding of € 4,898,562.93. 100% of eligible costs will be covered (up to a maximum of € 200,000), for each individual application sent. **Deadline:** the call expires on 13th December 2020. [All info on the call here \(it\).](#)

NEW TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES ON MOUNTAIN ISSUES! (IT)



The agricultural system of the Alpine Regions is characterized by small areas and fragmentation that allow production in quantities sufficient to cover fixed costs, but do not allow long-term investments, do not favour the professionalism of the agricultural operator and do not facilitate generational turnover. Production diversification could represent a first response to meet new market needs: the primary objective is to improve the competitiveness of agricultural and agro-industrial systems in a supply chain context. 
